General Membership Meeting

August 8, 2006

- Hunter Education Class will be held at HPSA on Tuesday 9/19/06 at 6pm, Thursday 9/21/06 at 6pm and Sunday 9/24/06 at 9am. Students must attend all three sessions.
- Induction of 10 new club members by Membership Secretary Gary DeLoof.
- Environmental committee update: wads from Trap field # 2 were cleaned up with a Turf vacuum (to test the effectiveness)

- First "Women's only Shooting" event approved for 9/9/06.
- 3-D Archery course is open every Thursday at 4pm.

Board Meeting

August 15, 2006

- Sporting Clays Director, Rich Pelt presented a proposal to the Board that would credit members who worked the open shoots (opening the Clubhouse, starting up the sporting clays course, loading birds in the trap/skeet houses loading the trap machines) to receive compensation in the form of 2 rounds of sporting clays or 4 rounds of Trap/Skeet for every 8 hours worked. The board discussed at length and decided to table until the next board meeting to consider other alternatives or options, including hiring someone to open.
- Environmental Committee provided an update on the Turf vacuum testing to clean the Trap & Skeet fields of wads and broken clays.
- Discussed smoke-eater equipment & costs, Don Martz will investigate 3 units that Perch Pointe has for sale.
- Approved Don Martz to purchase smoke-eaters from Perch Pointe for no more than \$1500, if these units will be sufficient.
- The Board was asked to obtain 3 estimates to provide cement in the pole barn.
