WE WILL BE REORGANIZING TEAMS AND THE SCHEDULE, UPDATING THE RSO LIST, ORDERING RSO SHIRTS AND COMING UP WITH IDEAS TO MAKE THE RANGE EVEN MORE PROFITABLE. PLEASE ARRANGE YOUR SCHEDULE SO THAT ALL RSO'S WILL BE IN ATTENDANCE. (NOTE: THIS IS A NO-SMOKING MEETING)

Proposed By-Law changes, scheduled for membership vote at the February 13, 2007 General Membership meeting:

Most changes are just restructuring. The Board of Directors have reviewed all proposed changes and gave their recommendation to approve (FOR) or reject (AGAINST) each as listed below.

- 1- Art: III, Part:1, Pg:2, Sec:3 = FOR, allows for new member installation if a By-Laws committee doesn't exist.
- 2 Art: IV, Pg:10, Sec:9 = FOR, Changes installation of Officers from January to December GMM.
- 3 Art: V, Pg:11, Sec:1 = AGAINST, proposal to allow alternate Board members to vote in the absence of any director at Board meetings. We have not experienced any problem establishing a quorum in past meetings. Alternates are not voting members of the Board and are not required to attend any BOD meetings, current Directors do not want someone voting in their place.
- 4 Art: V, Pg:11, Sec:3 = FOR, Condenses words and meaning remains the same.
- 5 Art: VII, Pg:15, Sec:2 = FOR, addresses a By-Laws infraction committed by a member of the By-Laws committee, would be reviewed by the Executive Board and not the By-Laws committee.
- 6 Art: XI, Pg:19, Sec:1 = AGAINST, New By-Law prohibiting alcohol on any ranges, This is already a Club rule and state law. By-Laws infractions require formal action for the By-Laws committee and the Board of Directors. Club Rules can be addressed less formally and re solved immediately without written protests and formal review meeting and discipline action.
- 7 Art: XI, Pg:19, Sec:2 = AGAINST, New By-Law to ban smoking in the Clubhouse before, during and after all meetings, dinners and events. We already have a Club Rule banning smoking during the GMM and again breaking a By-Law requires formal action rather then immediate action to correct the current situation.
- 8 Art: XI, Pg:19, Sec:3 = AGAINST, New By-Law to require all HPSA members to also become NRA members which would increase annual dues to cover this cost.
- 9 Art: XI, Pg:19, Sec:4 = FOR, New By-Law that states "No employee, independent contractor, or any person getting paid for their services at H.P.S.A. shall be a member of the Board of Directors.
