Board Meeting Highlights

September 18, 2007

Liquor License: Gallagher presented the proposed rules to be followed after the license is secured relative to the operation of the club bar. Gallagher noted the need for the committee to meet again to review changes that need to occur prior to opening.

Rifle Range: Suggestions were made to improve the use of the range and improve the safety of the range. The range needs greater advertising exposure in newspapers, sporting good stores and other clubs noting our new days and hours of operation during "Sight-in-days". Scheuer to arrange a mandatory meeting of RSO's to review the new improvements and changes.

Keying of the Office Door: The key to the club office door has been changed to limit access. Door is to be kept locked at all times.

Deer Hunting Lottery for use of club property: Roberts is in the process of selling lottery tickets for the upcoming deer season use of club property. Drawings will be held on the third Thursday of the month prior to the season opener following the Archery Shoot.

Coin Operated Controllors for the Trap & Skeet fields: Deloof reported on the discussions with the representatives of the Briley Corporation regarding the controllors, three controllors and 1,000 coins are to be purchased for the club.

Removal of trees on Sporting Clays course: Lori proposed a plan to remove some trees from the Sporting Clays Course to improve target visibility. In so doing it was suggested that we would be able to increase use of the course and make it more attractive to registered shooters.

2008 ATA Dates: Taylor reported that he has secured ATA shoots for 2008 at the recent meeting in Mason. The dates for HPSA Shoots 2007 are; May 18 (SCTP Shoot), June 1, July 20 and August 31-September 1 (Labor Day 2-day shoot).

Safety screen between Trap and Skeet Fields 1 & 2: Columbo and Watson previously introduced a plan to provide additional safety shielding between fields 1 & 2. Cost estimate was submitted and approved for a 24 foot long wooden shield to be constructed.

Winter Trap League: The Winter Trap League Dates are (2007-bank & shoot ahead) 12/2, 12/16 and 12/30, (2008) 1/6, 1/20, 1/27, 2/10, 2/17, 3/2, 3/16 and 4/6. The banquet will be held on April 19, 2008.

Wild Game Dinner: The dinner will be held on Saturday, March 29, 2008, more information is forthcoming.

Youth Archery: Young reported that the Youth Archery program would begin on December 16, 2007 (Orientation Day) with actual league shooting beginning on January 6, 2008. The banquet will be held on April 20, 2008.
