SCTP's summer has been a busy one. Following are some of our youths' successes this season.

June 22 – Michigan State Junior Olympic Competition @ Island Lakes State Park:

J1 Division (18-20 year old) - Clarence Van Camp Tied for 2nd place with a 116 of 125, thus qualifying to shoot the Fall Shoot in Colorado Springs, Colorado.

J2 Division (15-17 year old) – Matt Hines took 2nd with a 100 of 125, thus qualifying as an alternate to shoot the Fall Shoot in Colorado Springs, Colorado

J3 Division (14 & under) – Ben Wallace took 1st with a 100 of 125, thus qualifying as an alternate to shoot the Fall Shoot in Colorado Springs, Colorado

Joey Maniaci took 2nd with a 71, Anthony Ruggirello 3rd with a 63, & Matt Davis took 4th with a 59. (These 3 young shooters are first year shooters.)

June 28th – SCTP State Shoot:

Senior Squad #1 took 2nd Place in Senior Varsity Class with a 912 of 1000; Geno Salvatore - 193 (including his 1st 100 straight); Matt Hines -173; Clarence Van Camp - 181; Ben Wallace - 175 (including his 1st 50 straight), and Mike Sintebin

Senior Squad #2 scored 427 of 1000 Shay Hagel- 152 (including her 1st 25), Dalton Hagel - 168, and Dominique Ruggirello – 107 (she is a Junior Varsity and this is her first year shooting)

Intermediate Entry Level scored a 468 of 600 targets. Matt Davis – 131 (1st year), Robert Herrick III – 167 (Scoring his 1st 25 straight), and Tyler Lee – 170

Rookie squads was drawn at random from all participating clubs (no club had a full squad). Anthony Ruggirello (59 of 100) was on the Michigan State Rookie Championship 1st place team.

We have Senior Varsity Squad #1 and 2 Intermediate Entry Level shooters going to the SCTP Nationals in Sparta, IL on August 3-5. Wish them well.

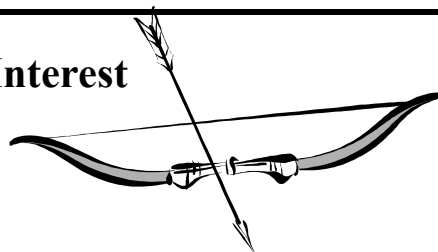
