Huron Pointe Clubhouse Rules

No Dogs in the Clubhouse

It is a Huron Pointe rule that NO dogs are allowed in the Clubhouse due to our Liquor License and food preparation that occasionally occurs in the Clubhouse. If you are asked by a Member to remove your dog from the Clubhouse you must do so immediately.

No Smoking in the Clubhouse

As of May 11, 2010 there is no smoking in ANY buildings in the State of Michigan; this includes private facilities. If you are smoking in the Clubhouse and are asked by a Member to stop, you must immediately extinguish your cigarette, pipe or cigar.

The aforementioned rules have been agreed upon by the Membership at General Membership Meetings and are enforceable by any Member of Huron Pointe. Huron Pointe is a self-governed organization therefore ANY Member can exercise their right to enforce Club Rules without reprisal. If another Member requests that you correct behavior that contradicts Huron Pointe's Rules you must immediately comply without argument. If you refuse to comply you will be asked to leave the premises, an incident report will be filed and this infraction will be reported to the Board of Directors for review under Huron Pointe's By-Laws, Article III, Section 10.
