

## RSO News

Attendance at the May RSO meeting was fantastic as was the work party that was held on May 14th. A great deal of cleanup was accomplished and most of the fencing was repaired! We still need to replace 10-12 of the vertical railroad ties that protect the uprights, re-number the shooting lanes, repaint the yellow line and the red firing line. Hopefully, the standing water will be dried up by then and we'll be able to knock these tasks off and more on the morning of the Club Clean-up day beginning at 9:00AM on Saturday, July 7th. Finally, we are in need of a couple of RSO's to open from 12:00-4:00PM on Wednesdays during the summer as well as a good organizer to coordinate and run some rifle and pistol leagues. For the latter, you do not need to be an RSO to be the league coordinator.



### Membership Dues

Huron Pointe By-Laws require that Members participate in Club Activities or Leagues (not just pay their fees), attend at least three (3) General Membership Meetings and perform at least twenty (20) hours of service at the Club. Membership dues must be paid on the 1st of May annually, with the latest payment received on May 15th. If you do not pay your dues on time you will be dropped and will lose all seniority and discounts you have earned as Members (ie. Green/Gold, Senior Rate, etc.). If you are having a hardship you must contact John Watson or Joe Burke immediately to avoid losing your earned time in the Club; any arrangements made will be kept confidential.

### Grounds Safety Patrols

A new opportunity to earn hours for the club is taking part in the "Grounds Safety Patrols" policing the Ranges while the Club is open. Areas needing to be overseen are 3D Archery, Sporting Clays and Trap/Skeet.
