We have now gotten by the preliminary ATA shoots and are moving on to the 2016 AIM Michigan State Shoot at the Michigan Trapshooting Home Grounds in Mason, MI. on July 2 & 3. 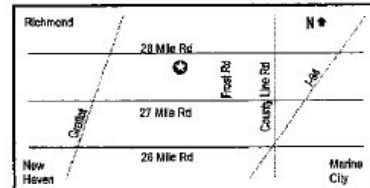
